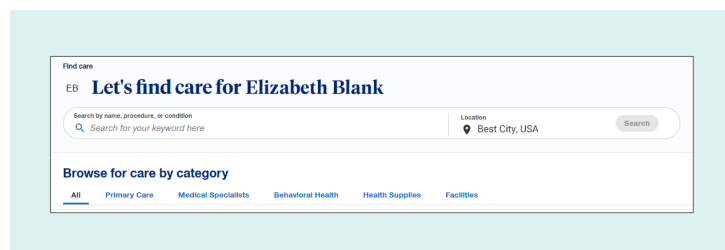
Compare quality and costs before you go
